Infants at Risk: Early Signs of Pre-Autism, Diagnosis and Treatment.

The Mifne Method was developed in 1987 as an early-intervention program of intensive individual therapy for young children diagnosed with autism and their nuclear families. The program for early detection and early intervention, including The early Signs of Pre-Autism Scale for Infants (ESPASI), a diagnostic instrument developed at the Mifne Centre (Alonim,2004) are presented.

Early Signs Relating to Posture and Communication: THE Child's Attitude and the mother's Reaction.

The younger the child, the more difficult it is to spot signs of communication disorders. The existence of a problem can also be detected in observing the behavior of the mother. Although she may be unaware of the specific nature of a problem, a mother generally senses if something is wrong and shows it in the way she acts and talks.

Echoes in the Nursery: Does our third Baby Have Autism Too?

The case study here involves a single family with 1) a preschooler with high functioning autism, 2) a toddler with regulatory issues, and 3) a newborn with early signs of autism. This presentation examines the issues facing the family and the clinician in providing sensitive intervention that addresses the problem of early identification as well as the interplay between constitutional factors and certain specifics of caregiving.

This presentation consists of four parts: 1) addresses the different types of onset, focusing primarily on the early- and the late-onset type; 2) describes pathways of early social and non-social attention in the first year of life; 3) examines the time as well as the type of onset, including the frequency and stability of symptoms during the first year of life; 4) examines recent research on late-onset children and the vulnerability of these children to regression.

The earliest Signs of Autism in Infants and treatment: Where we were and where we are.

By the 1970's, a great number of families had made home movies of their children who were later diagnosed with autism. A series of these movies were collected and analyzed for 1) Children's first signs of atypical behavior in the first six months of life, and 2) failure of social relatedness and cognitive growth in the second half of the first year through the third year of life. This presentation reviews this research into the natural history of autism prior to treatment, and offers illustrative vignettes from the film cases.
